[£]Since the vaccine is provided free of charge by the federal government, providers will not be reimbursed for the H1N1 vaccine itself. Health plans and other payors may request use of H1N1 vaccine codes for administrative purposes. Providers should confirm billing procedures with the individual health plans.
