

Dear VFC Provider,

The California VFC Program has a limited supply of digital data loggers (DDLs), ONSET InTemp CX-402, available for use in either your VFC refrigerator or VFC freezer vaccine storage unit (VFC provided data loggers are expected to be used as a primary device, not as a back-up). This data logger requires the use of an “app” (compatible with Android and Apple devices) for general operation, including viewing and downloading temperature data, checking logger status, setting alarms, creating and sharing secure PDF reports, etc. If eligible, your clinic must have a dedicated Bluetooth enabled mobile device (tablet or smart phone) in order to be able to manage this device.

Features include:

- Communicate wirelessly via Bluetooth Low Energy to mobile devices
- Built-in LCD display to view current and daily minimum and maximum temperatures
- Advanced audible and visual alarm capabilities for notification of temperature excursions
- Logger setup and download of data in seconds – *without a PC or cable*

To be eligible to receive this digital data logger from the VFC Program your practice must:

- Sign a Provider Agreement regarding its use
- Complete all training provided by the device vendor (training will be given at a later date to be determined)
- Maintain a dedicated Bluetooth enabled smart phone or mobile device to remain at the practice at all times

The VFC supply of these DDLs is limited and they must be used in VFC vaccine storage units only. Only one request per VFC PIN can be submitted. Providers that previously received a free CA VFC-supplied data logger are not eligible.

ALL VFC Providers must have a compliant [digital data logger](#) in place in all VFC vaccine storage units plus at least one backup device to complete 2018 VFC Recertification and to continue participation in the VFC Program.
