## Schools - Please Check Vaccine Records Are your students protected against measles? Are you ready for a case at your school?

Given the recent measles outbreak in California, CDPH recommends that schools review student records for their required vaccines.

All students who entered at kindergarten (including transitional kindergarten) and all students who advance or are admitted to 7<sup>th</sup> grade should have had 2 measles vaccine doses (typically MMR) or a valid exemption. Make sure you know which students are unimmunized and might need to stay home if measles comes to your school.

Should you belatedly discover students who have not met their school immunization requirements, the <u>California Code of Regulations (CCR)</u>, <u>Title 17</u>, <u>Sections 6040 and 6055</u> outlines how to follow up.

Conditional entrants: Schools are required to review records of students admitted conditionally until they have received all required immunizations, including measles vaccine [CCR, Title 17, Section 6070 (f)]. Continued attendance depends upon receipt of the remaining required doses within the times specified in Table 2 at CCR, Title 17, Sections 6020 and 6035.
