Be Prepared for the Start of 7th Grade: Check Vaccine Records Now Students Should Have 1 Tdap + 2 doses against measles

Before the start of the 2015-16 school year, make sure that your incoming 7th grade students are ready!

Vaccines required for 7th grade (<u>California Code of Regulations (CCR)</u>, <u>Title 17</u>, Section 6020) include:

- 1 dose of Tdap
- 2 doses of measles-containing vaccine: most students will have received these before starting Kindergarten, but some may have missed doses along the way.
- Other vaccines encouraged but not required for 7th graders include meningococcal and HPV vaccines.

To avoid the back-to-school rush, encourage 6th graders to make their vaccine appointments now – Spring Break may be a convenient time.

To ensure that students are up-to-date, schools may wish to start collecting and reviewing immunization records before summer break.

Should you belatedly discover that some K-12th grade students have not met their school immunization requirements, <u>California Code of Regulations (CCR)</u>, <u>Title 17</u>, <u>Sections 6040 and 6055</u> outlines how to follow-up.
