

Dear VFA Provider:

To increase access to VFA vaccines, sites are required to waive the administration fee and cost of the vaccine, as well as post a sign visible to patients stating that: *“FREE vaccines are available to adult patients who are uninsured or have insurance that doesn’t cover (certain) vaccines. We do not charge these patients for getting the vaccine or for the cost of the vaccine.”*

To assist VFA providers in meeting this requirement, two copies of the [VFA Patient Vaccine Poster](#) (one in English and one in Spanish) are being mailed to each VFA clinic location and should arrive today or tomorrow.

Please take the following steps:

- ✓ Notify appropriate staff of this mailing to ensure you receive these copies. The return addressee will be listed as “Immunization Branch / A. Gutman”
- ✓ Mark the checkboxes next to the VFA vaccines you offer
- ✓ Post this resource in your waiting room or other area visible to patients (if you do not already have a poster meeting the requirement)
