



Vaccine Tips

Helpful reminders about VFC vaccine orders:



Complete all sections of the order form, including doses used and vaccines in inventory.



If you have transferred, received, or returned VFC vaccines since your last order, be sure to complete and submit a Return or Transfer Report along with your order.



Anticipate increased and seasonal needs, e.g. influenza and back-to-school time, and order accordingly.



Make sure you have enough vaccine in stock to last until your order arrives. It may take up to 4 weeks to receive your order.



Notify VFC of any changes in your practice's shipping information.
