Annual Training Requirements Reminder

Have you taken the EZIZ lessons that will be required for the 2014 VFC Annual Recertification? The designated Vaccine Coordinator of every enrolled VFC practice must complete the following EZIZ lessons between January 2013 and December 2013:

- 1) Storing Vaccines
- 2) Monitoring Refrigerator Temperatures
- 3) Monitoring Freezer Temperatures
- 4) Conducting a Vaccine Inventory
- 5) VFC Program Requirement Overview (available this fall – providers will be notified when available)

In addition, the Provider of Record of every enrolled VFC practice must also take the VFC Program Requirement lesson when it becomes available this fall.
