Weekly Wrap Up – January 28, 2021

Updates & Reminders for Moderna Vaccine

FDA recently approved updates to the Moderna COVID-19 vaccine label and EUA fact sheet to indicate a 5.5mL volume. Distribution of the Moderna vials with the updated labels began during the week of January 13, 2021.



What Has Changed on the Label?

- Label has been updated to indicate a volume of 5.5mL
- Doses for primary series and booster shots are now listed on the label
- Important reminder added not to exceed a maximum of 20 punctures per vial

When Administering Moderna Vaccine

For primary series doses only: Depending on the syringes and needles used, a maximum of 11 doses (range: 10-11 doses) may be extracted from the vial.

For booster doses: Do not exceed a maximum of 20 punctures per vial.

When Reporting Moderna Vaccine Doses

For inventory purposes, CDC provides the following guidance:

• Report spoiled, expired, or wasted doses to myCAvax: Continue to report wastage up to 10 doses (primary series) and 20 doses (booster doses) for 5.5 mL vials.

multiples of 14 (primary series) and 20 (booster doses). Please continue to report inventory daily to VaccineFinder—even if inventory quantities haven't changed while you have COVID-19 vaccine on hand. (Daily reporting is not required when inventory is depleted.) Thank you for your continued efforts to help track inventory throughout California!

Check Vaccine Expiration Dates

Please continue to regularly check COVID-19 vaccine inventory for expired vaccine and immediately remove expired inventory to prevent it from being administered.

Providers can register for CDC's Vaccine Lot Number and Expiration Date webpage (click the "Register" button in the upper right-hand corner to complete the registration form) for all COVID-19 vaccines or use the Moderna Vial Expiration Date Look-up Tool (locate the lot number printed on the carton of vial).

Adding New Vaccine Products to VaccineFinder

Before receiving new vaccine products, add the vaccines using the COVID Locating Health portal so you can report the inventory to VaccineFinder. Sites can add vaccines across multiple locations in a single flow.

Just click the **Add Vaccines** button from any screen in the Update Vaccine Inventory tab to get started. Refer to Reporting Inventory to VaccineFinder for details.

- 1. Choose vaccine(s) to add.
- 2. Choose location(s) administering the new vaccine.
- 3. Confirm that the tracker shows number of selected vaccines (and selected locations below).

- Order mRNA vaccines as primary source of COVID-19 vaccine (mRNA vaccines are preferentially recommended).
