COVID-19 Vaccine Timing: Second Dose

When should patients receive their second dose of Pfizer or Moderna? The recommended timing of a second dose depends on each patient's situation, including risk of severe COVID-19 and the risk of getting infected before the second dose. Please view this [new job aid](#) for further information.

COVID-19 Treatments

The Biden/Harris Administration announced the [Test-to-Treat Initiative](#) that will give individuals a new way to access treatment for COVID-19. These locations will be available at hundreds of locations nationwide. Health and Human Services (HHS) is developing a finder site for T2T sites.

Test-to-Treat California Health Alert Network (CAHAN) recommendations:

- Practice equity in making T2T open to all individuals
- Provide comprehensive end-to-end test and treat services
- Either conduct rapid test onsite or evaluate home tests
- Provide timely and thorough assessment and discussion relevant to treatment option(s)
- Have a co-located pharmacy able to readily dispense oral medications to eligible patients
- Have a plan to refer patients to infusion services should oral medications not be appropriate

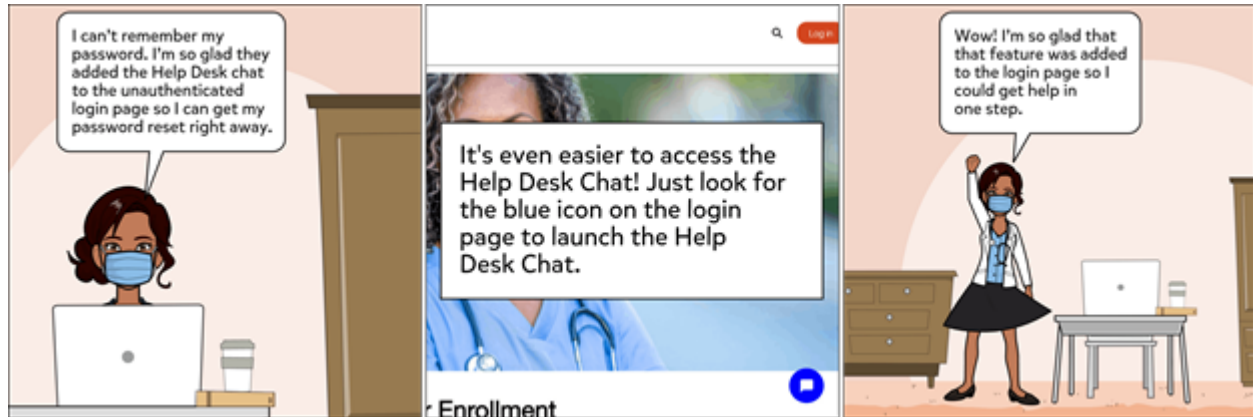
myCAvax Reminders

Moderna Smaller Vials

- Moderna is likely to come out with smaller vials that contain 5 **booster** doses starting next month.
- This is a good option to prevent waste, but may cause difficulties with vaccine management for some providers.
- CDPH is waiting on CDC for more guidance on how to manage the booster-only vials.

Multisystem Inflammatory Syndrome in Children

MIS-C is a rare inflammatory condition associated with COVID-19 that can damage organs, may require hospitalization, and be life-threatening. MIS-C most commonly affects school-age children and can occur even after mild COVID-19.

Protect children from MIS-C by getting them vaccinated against COVID-19!

COVID-19 Antibody Study



Beginning April 1, 2022, households in Alameda, El Dorado, Kern, Los Angeles, Monterey, San Diego and Shasta counties will receive invitation letters to participate in [CalScope, California's COVID-19 antibody study](#). This study invites participants to complete an anonymous survey and free antibody blood test at home. Results will help the California Department of Public Health better understand how many people in California have antibodies to SARS-CoV-2 (through past infection or vaccination), and how population immunity in California is changing over time.

Households are randomly selected to participate and can earn up to \$80 in gift cards. Invited households are encouraged to join regardless of their vaccination status.
