California COVID-19 Vaccination Program Update

Updated Interim Clinical Considerations

CDC has issued updated [Interim Clinical Considerations](#) regarding booster doses of COVID-19 vaccines. The Western States Scientific Safety Review Workgroup [released a statement](#) affirming these updates.

Second Booster Shot for Some Individuals

Based on [expanded FDA EUAs](#), [the following individuals may receive a second booster dose](#) at least four months after their first booster dose:

- People 12 years and older who are moderately or severely immunocompromised
- People 50 years and older who are not moderately or severely immunocompromised
- People 18-49 years old who are not moderately or severely immunocompromised and who received Janssen COVID-19 vaccine as both their primary series dose and booster dose

Other Updates

- Further clarification of safety issues including those related to [multisystem inflammatory syndrome in children \(MIS-C\) and adults \(MIS-A\)](#) and [myocarditis](#).
- Updated information on the availability of Moderna COVID-19 Vaccine supplied in a vial with a red cap (0.25 mL dosage volume) and Moderna COVID-19 Vaccine supplied in a vial with a blue cap (0.5 mL dosage volume) for administration of a 50 µg booster dose.
