CDC and WSSSRW Infant/Toddler COVID-19 Vaccine Recommendations

On Friday, June 17, the [Food and Drug Administration authorized Moderna and Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 Vaccines](#) for Children 6 months through 5 years of age. Following the authorization by the FDA both the [Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices](#) (ACIP) and the [Western States Scientific Review Workgroup](#) (WSSSRW) released statements recommending these vaccines for children ages 6 months through 5 years.
