- ✓ Eligible patients who are 5 years and older can find and make appointments for Pfizer Bivalent Booster (ages 5-11) and Moderna Bivalent Booster (ages 6-17).

- ✓ Clinic Managers can set up clinics for Pfizer Bivalent Booster (5-11 and 12+ years) and Moderna Bivalent Booster (6-11 and 12+ years), create vaccine supplies, vaccine inventory, edit patient IIS appointment records, bulk upload / cancel, filter, single edit, and cancel appointments.
- ✓ Vaccine Administrators can create Pfizer Bivalent Booster (5-11 and 12+ years) and Moderna Bivalent Booster (6-11 and 12+ years) appointments via CSV & Inline Bulk upload options.
- ✓ Vaccine Administrators can administer the Pfizer Bivalent Booster (5-11 and 12+ years) and Moderna Bivalent Booster (6-11 and 12+ years) vaccines to eligible patients.
- ✓ Clinic Managers and Vaccine Administrators cannot create Monovalent Booster walk-in appointments for 5-11-year-old patients and must select one from these options: First Dose, Second Dose, Additional Dose, or Bivalent Booster.

- ✓ CMs and VAs can skip the second question about homelessness in the walk-in flow that asks, "Is the place where you sleep a house/apartment, emergency shelter, tent/encampment, vehicle, or on the street?" It has been made optional.
- ✓ VAs can view an additional checkbox under the VA flow confirming if the patient has received their last dose of vaccine 28 days ago.
- ✓ CMs and VAs can view additional checkboxes when scheduling an in-home vaccination appointment for COVID, flu or MPX vaccine.
- ✓ VAs can view two new options under the Injection Site field when administering vaccine to a patient.
- ✓ CMs and VAs can see additional screening questions when resubmitting or editing a COVID-19 vaccine record.
- ✓ CMs can view updated dashboards with Vaccinia and MPX appointments.

Pfizer Pediatric Bivalent Booster Update

CDPH expects to receive an additional Pfizer Pediatric Bivalent Booster allocation on October 20. Pre-orders are shipping now. Orders placed after the pre-order deadline will ship as soon as pre-order shipment has completed.

LHJs May Order MPX Vaccine for Providers

Providers and LHJs



LHJs may order MPX vaccine for Provider Locations from the Vaccine Order Review screen. The minimum MPX order will be 20 vials and in 20 vial increments. LHJs will not need to enter a transfer to the Provider Location if the MPX vaccine is ordered directly to the Location.

Viewing the New Bivalent Booster Product Grouping

Providers



Providers can identify adult and pediatric Bivalent Booster vaccines on the **New Vaccine Order Request** page using the **Booster** grouping and viewing indicated age ranges, like **Pfizer Bivalent Booster (5 yrs. – 11 yrs.)** and **Pfizer Bivalent Booster (12 yrs. – 100+ yrs)**. Providers should order **Moderna Bivalent Booster (6 yrs. – 100+ yrs)** for patients across all age groups. The pediatric volume and dosage are half the amount administered to adults.

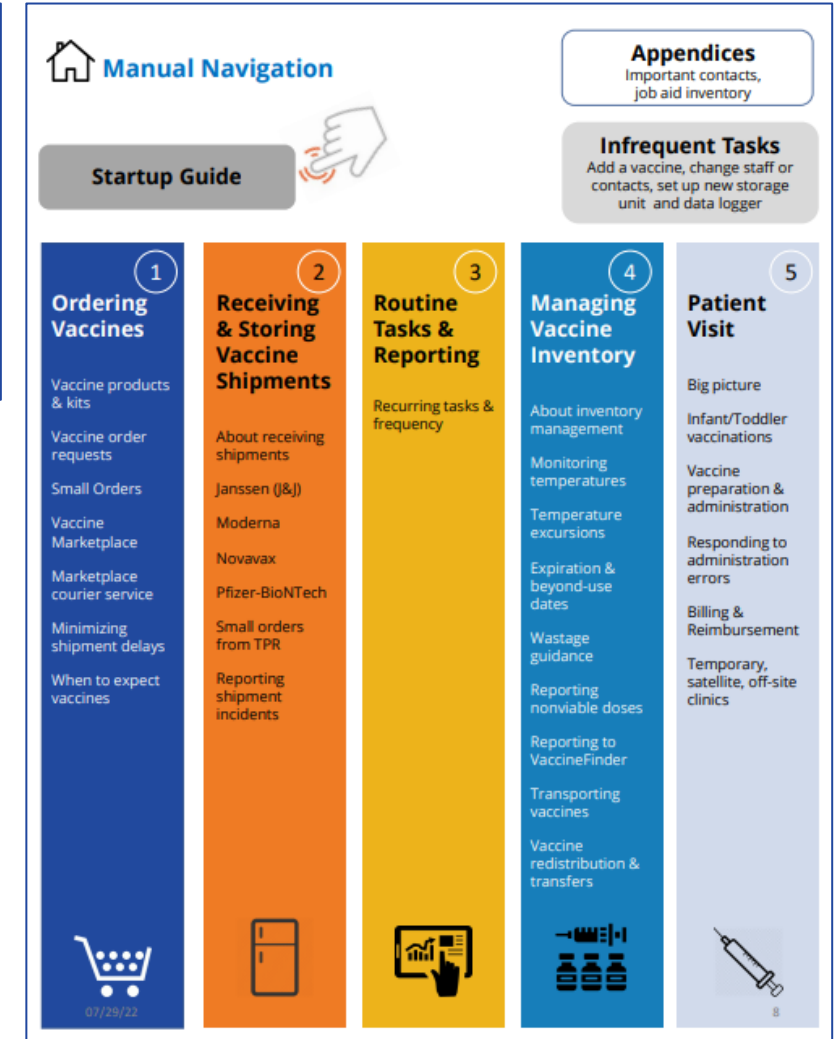

Receiving & Storing Vaccines

Moderna Vaccine, Bivalent 6Y+ Fact Sheet


Moderna COVID-19 Vaccine, Bivalent (Original, Omicron BA.4/BA.5) is authorized as a single booster dose for 6Y+ (half-dose for ages 6-11Y). Vial has a dark blue cap and gray label border. **DO NOT DILUTE.** [Highlighted resources to be updated soon.](#)

- Vaccine ships frozen between -50°C and -15°C (-58°F and 5°F). For receiving, see [How to Receive Moderna Vaccines](#).
- Order quantity calculated based on adult doses; use for pediatric and adult boosters as authorized and recommended.
- 2 ancillary kits ship by default to support half-dose boosters for ages 6-11Y; locations may opt out if kits aren't needed; kits ship separately.



- Store unpunctured vials in a freezer at -50°C to -15°C (-58°F to 5°F) **until expiration** or refrigerator at 2°C to 8°C (36°F to 46°F) for up to **30 days** or hold at 8°C to 25°C (46°F to 77°F) for up to **24 hours** before first puncture.
- [Organize storage units](#) to reduce administration errors; group products by age and label cartons, baskets, or shelf space in large letters.
- Apply [storage and beyond-use date tracking labels](#) to prevent administration errors.



- Read label carefully; don't rely on cap color. Look for BIVALENT on label.
- Hold punctured vials at 2°C to 25°C (36°F to 77°F) for up to **12 hours** then discard. **Do NOT refreeze thawed vaccine.**
- **Dosing volume:** **Ages 12+** 0.5 mL; **Ages 6-11** .25 mL (up to 10 doses/vial). Do not use for primary series. Both 0.5 mL and 0.25 mL doses may be withdrawn from same vial. Don't pool excess vaccine from multiple vials.
- Report all wastage as adult doses. **Do not report if 5 doses are used.**
- Expiration date is not printed on vial or carton; scan QR code on carton or [look up online](#) to find expiration date and extension; write date on carton.
- **Do not use vaccine after the earliest expiration or beyond-use date.**

Receiving & Storing Vaccines


Pfizer-BioNTech Vaccine, Bivalent 5-11Y Fact Sheet

Product (COVID-19 Vaccine, mRNA) is authorized under EUA as a booster for individuals 5 through 11 years. **MUST DILUTE.** Vial has an orange cap and label border. Look for BIVALENT on label. **Highlighted CDC resources to be updated soon.**

- Vaccines ship from the manufacturer with dry ice and between -90°C and -60°C (-130°F to -76°F); ensure staff are trained on [dry ice safety](#).
- May not opt out of ancillary kits containing diluent.
- Vaccine ships in a small, single-use shipper; dispose of shipper; do NOT use shipper for vaccine storage. Ancillary kit with diluent ships separately.
- For receiving, see [How to Receive Pfizer-BioNTech Vaccines](#) or [this video](#).



- Store unpunctured vials in ULT unit (-90 to -60°C) **until expiration** or refrigerator at 2-8°C (36-46°F) for up to **10 weeks** or at 8°C to 25°C (46°F to 77°F) for up to **12 hours** before first puncture. Protect from light.
- [Organize storage units](#) to reduce administration errors; group products by age and label cartons, baskets, or shelf space in large letters.
- Apply [storage and beyond-use date tracking labels](#) to prevent administration errors.



- Identical packing to monovalent product. Look for BIVALENT on label.
- Dosing volume 0.2 mL after dilution. Don't pool excess vaccine from multiple vials. **Do not use for primary series.**
- Store punctured vials at 2°C to 25°C (35°F to 77°F) for up to **12 hours** then discard vaccine. **Do NOT refreeze thawed vaccine.**
- Manufacture date is printed on vial; check Pfizer's [expiry lookup tool](#) for expiration dates and extensions.
- **Do not use vaccine after the earliest expiration or beyond-use date.**

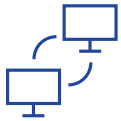
