



# New COVID-19 Vaccine School Requirement

- Students will be required to be vaccinated for in-person learning starting the term following FDA full approval of the vaccine for their grade span (7-12 and K-6).
- Accomplished by regulations promulgated pursuant to section 120335(b)(11), which authorizes vaccine requirements for “any other disease deemed appropriate” by CDPH.
- Requirements established by regulation, not legislation, must be subject to exemptions “for both medical reasons and personal beliefs.” (HSC section 120338).
- All staff will be required to be vaccinated no later than when the requirement takes effect for students.



## California Becomes First State in Nation to Announce COVID-19 Vaccine Requirements for Schools

Oct 1, 2021

After implementing first-in-the-nation school masking and staff vaccination measures, California becomes the first state to announce plans to require student vaccinations – adding the COVID-19 vaccine to list of vaccinations required for school, such as the vaccines...



# Doses Administered to Date (10/6/21)


**50,214,151** doses administered!

- **26,766,148 people** with at least one dose (24,045,374 people fully protected)
- **79.1%** of 12+ population has received at least one dose and 71.1% are fully protected!
- **81.7%** of 65+ population has received at least one dose and 74.3% are fully protected.
- **64.4%** of 12-to-17-year-olds have received at least one dose and 56.1% are fully protected.
  - Opportunities to still vaccinate 1,123,046 12-to-17-year-olds
- In the 12+ age group, 22 counties are above the 75% vaccination goal
- In the 18+ age group, 26 counties are above 75% vaccination goal



# Vaccine Equity Metric

- HPI Quartile1 vaccine rates outpaced all other quartiles for 18 weeks in a row, with Quartile 2 in second place.
- In the week ending 9/26, Q1 populations received 30.5% total doses
- **72.8%** of Q1 population has received at least one dose with 63.0% fully protected.
- **76.4%** of Q2 population has received at least one dose with 67.6% fully protected.




# Unvaccinated and Vaccinated Data

## Unvaccinated and vaccinated data

Vaccines prevent serious illness, save lives, and reduce further spread of COVID-19. As more people are vaccinated, the virus is less likely to spread, mutate, and potentially become even more dangerous. Vaccines will help put an end to the pandemic.



From September 19, 2021 to September 25, 2021, unvaccinated people were **7.1 times more likely** to get COVID-19 than fully vaccinated people.




## Unvaccinated and vaccinated data

Vaccines prevent serious illness, save lives, and reduce further spread of COVID-19. As more people are vaccinated, the virus is less likely to spread, mutate, and potentially become even more dangerous. Vaccines will help put an end to the pandemic.



From September 5, 2021 to September 11, 2021, unvaccinated people were **17.4 times more likely** to die from COVID-19 than fully vaccinated people.





# Vaccination After COVID-19 Disease

CDC continues to recommend that people with a history of SARS-CoV-2 infection receive complete vaccine course due to following:

- No correlate of protection, so no easy, reliable way to determine if someone is immune
- Duration of immunity after COVID-19 disease unknown
- Vaccination provides improved protection than history of disease alone



# Recording an Additional or Booster Dose on COVID-19 Vaccination Cards

In the "Other" row on the vaccination card, record vaccine administration information such as date and formulation for an additional or booster dose.

The dose does not necessarily need to be labeled with the term "additional" or "booster."



# Provider Call Center – Order Communications

## Reasons for orders "In Review"

- Outdated Vaccine Finder inventory reporting
- Large order with large on-hand inventory
- Both outdated Vaccine Finder inventory and large on-hand inventory

## Communication



Email provider; LHD cc'd for awareness



Timely responses will ensure orders are included in end-of-week order review and fulfillment

## Tips and tricks!



- ✓ Keep Vaccine Finder inventory up to date daily
- ✓ Leave Order Comments, i.e., events, new order needs, boosters, expired inventory, etc.

# Moderna Shelf-life Extension

- We are expecting a shelf-life extension for the Moderna vaccine.
  - Two additional months at frozen temperatures
- **Do not dispose of expired Moderna vaccine until there is decision made about extension.**
- We recommend marking these doses as “DO NOT USE pending extension decision,” keeping them within required temperature ranges, and checking Moderna's expiry [website](#) when the extension is announced.
- No extensions for the Janssen (J&J) vaccine.

# Shelf-life Extension and BUD Reminder

- Critical to pay attention to details of a shelf-life extension
  - The shelf-life extension typically applies to long-term storage conditions and does not necessarily extend or change the Beyond Use Date (BUD).
  - **Example:** Pfizer shelf-life extension only applies to vaccine stored in ultra-cold temperatures. It does not allow the vaccine to be stored for multiple additional months in the refrigerator.
- If vaccine reaches its Beyond Use Date before its expiration date, it must be disposed of!




# Third-party Redistributor (TPR) Orders

- We have heard that some providers left TPR small order shipments in the mail room upon arrival because of lack of noticeable identifying information on the packages.
- TPR is going to add more noticeable stickers to their shipping boxes.
- **Important:** Please remind mail room staff to be on the lookout for these boxes and to immediately notify the Vaccine Coordinator at your facility when they arrive.

# Pfizer Ages 5-11

Q: If the vaccine is authorized for children 5 to <12 years, can I use a vial of vaccine of the current formulation (purple cap) to provide a dose to a child in this age group?

 **No.** For children **under 12 years** of age you **cannot** use the current formulation.

- The **current formulation (purple cap)** is authorized for use in individuals **aged 12 and older**.
- If the vaccine receives emergency use authorization for children **5 to < 12 years**, a **separate vaccine formulation (orange cap)** specific for a **10mcg dose** will be introduced.



**Note:** Use of the current formulation (purple cap) to prepare doses for children 5 to <12 years would result in an **injection volume** for the 10mcg dose of 0.1mL, which is both generally considered **too small** for typical IM injections and **has not been studied**."

## Recommended Workflow

1

Create new clinic for Additional Dose / Booster vaccine supply **only**

2

Add “Booster Only”, “Additional Dose Only”, or “Additional Dose / Booster Only” to **Clinic Name**

3

Select the “**Additional Dose / Booster**” **checkbox** in “*What types of appointments will your clinic host? Please select all that apply.*” field

4

Control **clinic’s visibility** with these fields:

- Exclude from Public Site
- Availability Date
- Clinic Start Date





# Third-party Redistributor (AmerisourceBergen)

**AmerisourceBergen has successfully transitioned their warehouse location to Reno, NV. No disruptions in the order fulfillment process were created.**

- We are implementing a process to collect information, possibly every 2 weeks
- We are working with MCEs and LHDs for this process
- We may have ad-hoc trainings in the future

# myCAvax – Known Issues & Workarounds

## **Known Issue**

### **Order Maximum for Products**

- ✓ Need to have order maximum validation for Pfizer and Moderna products
- ✓ Currently, allows Standard Order requests to be over the CDC Maximum

## **Workaround**

### **No workaround identified**

- ✓ In the meantime, do not allow doses requested on Standard Orders to be over the CDC Maximum
- ✓ Estimated fix: 10/7

# What's Next on myCAvax: Release 17 (10/7)

## Small Order Processing

- ✓ Added 'Update Order Status' button on the Order Fulfillment page for LHDs. When button is selected, completed orders are marked as 'Complete', the shipment record is created, 'Order Fulfillment' object status is updated, and the 'inventory summary' record is created. When 'Upload Fulfillment File' button is selected and user selects 'Finish' on the pop-up screen, orders will no longer be available for editing

## Products

- ✓ Added order maximum validation rules and error messages for Pfizer and Moderna products for LHDs and Provider.
- ✓ Configured Order Maximums for Pfizer (10530) and Moderna (10500) products on Standard Orders – LHD / Providers can view but not edit order maximums






