

California COVID-19 Vaccination Program Update

Dear Providers Receiving Shipments of Moderna Vaccine—

CDC will begin processing your initial Moderna COVID-19 vaccine orders this week assuming the EUA for this vaccine is issued by the FDA. Upon EUA issuance, provider sites will receive vaccine over three days – currently, CDC estimate these deliveries to occur Monday through Wednesday, December 21-23.

Anticipated timeline (assumes EUA is issued this weekend):

- Ancillary kits for Day 1 sites will begin arriving Thursday, December 17
- Vaccine will begin arriving Monday, December 21

All jurisdictions will receive some vaccine Day 1 (vaccine for the Pacific Islands will ship but may arrive later).

- Ancillary supplies will arrive before vaccine
- Orders by day will be provided to each jurisdiction this weekend so you will know what to expect at each site
