COVID-19 Vaccine Products Possibly Up for Review by the FDA in the Coming Months

Pfizer

- Full licensure for primary series, adolescents 12-15 years: [Submitted December 16, 2021](#)
- Emergency use authorization (EUA) for booster dose, children 5-11 years: [Submitted April 26, 2022](#)
- Emergency use authorization (EUA) for children 6 months to under 5 years: *Not yet submitted*

Moderna

- Emergency use authorization (EUA) for primary series, children 6 months to under 6 years: [Submitted April 28, 2022](#)
- Emergency use authorization (EUA) for primary series, children 6-11 years: [Submitted March 23, 2022](#)
- Emergency use authorization (EUA) for primary series, adolescents 12-17 years: [Submitted June 10, 2021](#), *updated submission pending*

Novavax

- Emergency use authorization (EUA) for adults 18 and over: [Submitted January 31, 2022](#)

Updated CDC Guidance for COVID-19 Vaccine Booster for People with Prior or Current SARS-CoV-2 Infection

People with known current SARS-CoV-2 infection should defer any COVID-19 vaccination, including booster vaccination, at least until recovery from the acute illness (if symptoms were present) and [criteria](#) to discontinue isolation have been met. In addition, people who recently had SARS-CoV-2 infection may consider **delaying their first or second COVID-19 booster dose by 3 months from symptom onset or positive test (if infection was asymptomatic)**.

Reminder: Effective May 1, VaccineFinder reporting will be weekly!

Starting May 1, 2022, providers must report COVID-19 vaccine inventory **at least weekly by close of business on Fridays**. Please note: This is ONLY applicable to inventory reporting and all other requirements (including daily vaccine administration reporting) remain unchanged.
