

Q: Where can I find information about the Janssen by Johnson & Johnson shelf-life extension?

A: The FDA authorized an extension of the shelf life for the Janssen COVID-19 vaccine from 4 ½ months to 6 months. For information on storage temperature requirements, please visit FDA EAU Amendment and Johnson & Johnson Statement on Extended Shelf Life. COVID-19 vaccine Providers can check COVID-19 vaccine expiration dates for the Janssen by Johnson & Johnson vaccine at Vial Expiration Date Lookup: Janssen.



Q: Are healthcare workers required to receive the COVID-19 vaccination?

A: The California Department of Public Health released a state order that requires healthcare facilities to verify the vaccination status of workers, or have workers undergo regular testing. For detailed guidelines and information, please visit State Public Health Officer Order of July 26, 2021.



Q: Which COVID-19 vaccines are available for ordering in myCAvax?

A: The Moderna 140-dose shipments and Pfizer 450-dose shipments are available for Standard Orders in myCAvax. The Janssen from Johnson & Johnson, smaller orders of Moderna, and the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine can be requested through the myCAvax Vaccine Marketplace and Small Order Requests in myCAvax, dependent upon availability.

Doses Administered to Date (7/28/21)

43,772,466 doses administered!

- 71.8% of 12+ population has received at least one dose and 62.4% is fully protected!
- Good news in that total doses (1st, 2nd, & J&J) increased by 20,766 doses between July 12 and July 19 for a 4.77% increase!*


*Contributing factors include more primary care providers vaccinating, fear of delta variant, trusted messengers actively outreaching, availability of J&J vaccine at events, stellar staff!!








Communication Campaigns Updates:

- -NUNA's continues to encourage people to redeem their \$50 incentive cards. Eligibility ended on 7/18, but redemption rates are low.








VFC Onboarding Status as of 7/26

- 100% of the 166 providers received a comm. (5/20)

CalVaxGrant Update

Funded by CDPH and administered by Physicians for a Healthy California (PHC), the <u>CalVaxGrant</u> offers grant funding, one-on-one myCAvax support, and vaccine administration resources for medical practices administering COVID-19 vaccines. **Grant ending August 13**th, **2021**.



Updated Eligibility

- ✓ Physician medical practice* with ≤ 200 physicians or independent pharmacy organization Additional eligibility forthcoming
- ✓ Be enrolled in myCAvax
- Expend or plan to expend \$10,000 between 11/1/2020 11/1/2021
 - Allowable expenses include staffing, training, technology, infrastructure, supplies / equipment and administrative overhead







New Public Health Officer Order

Order for healthcare and congregate settings (7/26)

<u>Unvaccinated Workers in</u> <u>High-Risk Settings</u>

Order applies to the following facilities:

A. Acute Health Care and Long-Term Care Settings:

- 1. General Acute Care Hospitals
- 2. Skilled Nursing Facilities (including Subacute Facilities)
- 3. Intermediate Care Facilities

B. High-Risk Congregate Settings:

- 4. Adult and Senior Care Facilities
- 5. Homeless Shelters
- 6. State and Local Correctional Facilities and Detention Centers

C. Other Health Care Settings:

- 7. Acute Psychiatric Hospitals
- 8. Adult Day Health Care Centers
- 9. Adult Day Programs Licensed by the California DSS
- 10. Program of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly (PACE) and PACE Centers
- 11. Ambulatory Surgery Centers
- 12. Chemical Dependency Recovery Hospitals
- 13. Clinics & Doctor Offices (including behavioral health, surgical)
- 14. Congregate Living Health Facilities
- 15. Dental Offices
- 16. Dialysis Centers
- 17. Hospice Facilities
- 18. Pediatric Day Health and Respite Care Facilities
- 19. Residential Substance Use and Mental Health Treatment Facilities



New CDPH Public Health Officer Order

- Requires facilities to <u>verify vaccine status of workers</u> or be tested at least once per week, depending on facility type
- Requires facilities to provide appropriate PPE/respirator or mask to unvaccinated/partially vaccinated workers, depending on facility type





FDA Review of Pfizer Full-Licensure Application

- Pfizer submitted Biologics License Application (BLA) requesting licensure (full approval) of Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 Vaccine for prevention of COVID-19 in individuals > 16 years
- FDA has granted application priority review
- FDA news release: July 16, 2021



Storage & Handling

Janssen/J&J Extension

- J&J was granted another 45-day shelf-life extension
 - The stability data has determined that the vaccine has a 6-month shelf life when refrigerated at 36 – 46° Fahrenheit (2 – 8° Celsius)
- There is a lot of J&J vaccine across the state that had August expiry dates, so now most of those doses will expire in September!
- Check the new expiry date of your J&J vaccine: <u>Janssen COVID-19</u>
 <u>Vaccine Expiry Checker (vaxcheck.jnj)</u>
- If you have posted doses of J&J/Janssen COVID-19 doses on the Marketplace, please review your post and update the expiration information accordingly.



General Waste and Expiry Guidance

- If you have vaccine doses that have expired, remove expired vaccine from the storage unit <u>immediately</u> so staff do not inadvertently administer expired vaccine.
- Dispose of the vaccine vial (with any remaining doses) in a pharmaceutical waste or Sharps container, according to local and state regulations.
- There is no return program for COVID-19 vaccines, so providers must dispose of their own vaccines!


