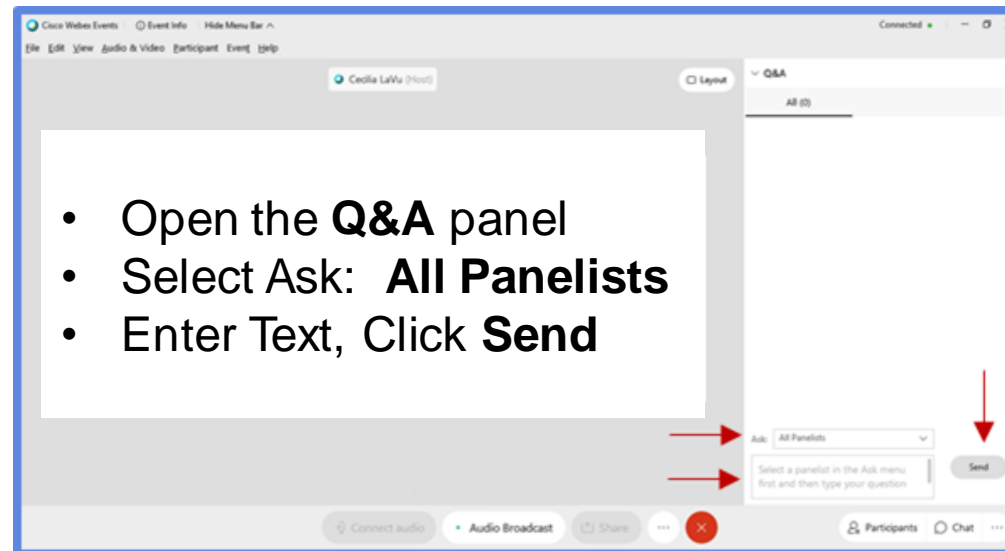

**Q: Where can COVID-19 vaccine Providers find information on the Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine expiration extension?**

A: The FDA authorized an expiration extension for the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine from 6 months to 9 months. COVID-19 vaccine Providers can visit the [COVID-19 Vaccine Lot Number and Expiration Dates](#) webpage to confirm the latest expiration dates of vaccine. **Q: Where can COVID-19 vaccine Providers find guidance on the full approval of the Pfizer-BioNTech (Comirnaty) vaccine?**

A: The FDA granted full approval for the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine, which will now be marketed as Comirnaty, for use as a two-dose series in individuals 16 years of age and older. The Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine continues to be available under emergency use authorization (EUA), for individuals 12 through 15 years of age and for third dose administration in certain immunocompromised individuals. **Q: Should the same mRNA vaccine as the initial vaccination series be given for additional COVID-19 doses?**

A: Yes. The additional mRNA COVID-19 vaccine dose should be the same vaccine as the initial two-dose primary vaccination series (Pfizer or Moderna). If the mRNA COVID-19 vaccine product given for the first two doses is not available, the other mRNA COVID-19 vaccine product may be administered. ## HOW DOES THE VACCINE WORK?

Scientists have made the COVID-19 vaccines by using part of the virus's genetic code, either a messenger RNA (mRNA) or DNA, depending on the type of vaccine. Once inside the cell, this piece of the genetic code gives instructions to make a small, harmless piece of the COVID-19 virus called the spike protein. Our body notices the spike protein, and the immune system makes antibodies to destroy the spike proteins. This process teaches your body how to recognize and fight

against the virus. If you are exposed to the virus in the future, even currently circulating variants of the virus, your immune system will quickly recognize the virus and have the antibodies and T-cells ready to fight infection.

## IS THE VACCINE SAFE?

Yes, the vaccines are highly effective at preventing people from getting seriously ill, being hospitalized, or death.

## IS COVID-19 STILL A THREAT?

Yes. Viruses constantly change through mutation resulting in variants. As expected, multiple variants of SARS-CoV-2 have been documented in the United States and globally throughout this pandemic. The COVID-19 vaccine is our best tool in stopping the development of new variants and ending the pandemic.

## WHAT ABOUT THE RISK OF UNKNOWN LONG-TERM SIDE EFFECTS?

The nation's immunization experts study and analyze all reports of any possible serious side effects following a COVID-19 vaccine. A specialized committee of the CDC meets frequently to examine vaccine safety issues. In their most recent meeting, on July 22, the group maintained its strong encouragement that everyone ages 12 and older get vaccinated against COVID-19, finding that the benefits of vaccination far outweigh any harm.

## DOES THE VACCINE IMPACT FERTILITY AND IS IT SAFE FOR PREGNANT PEOPLE?

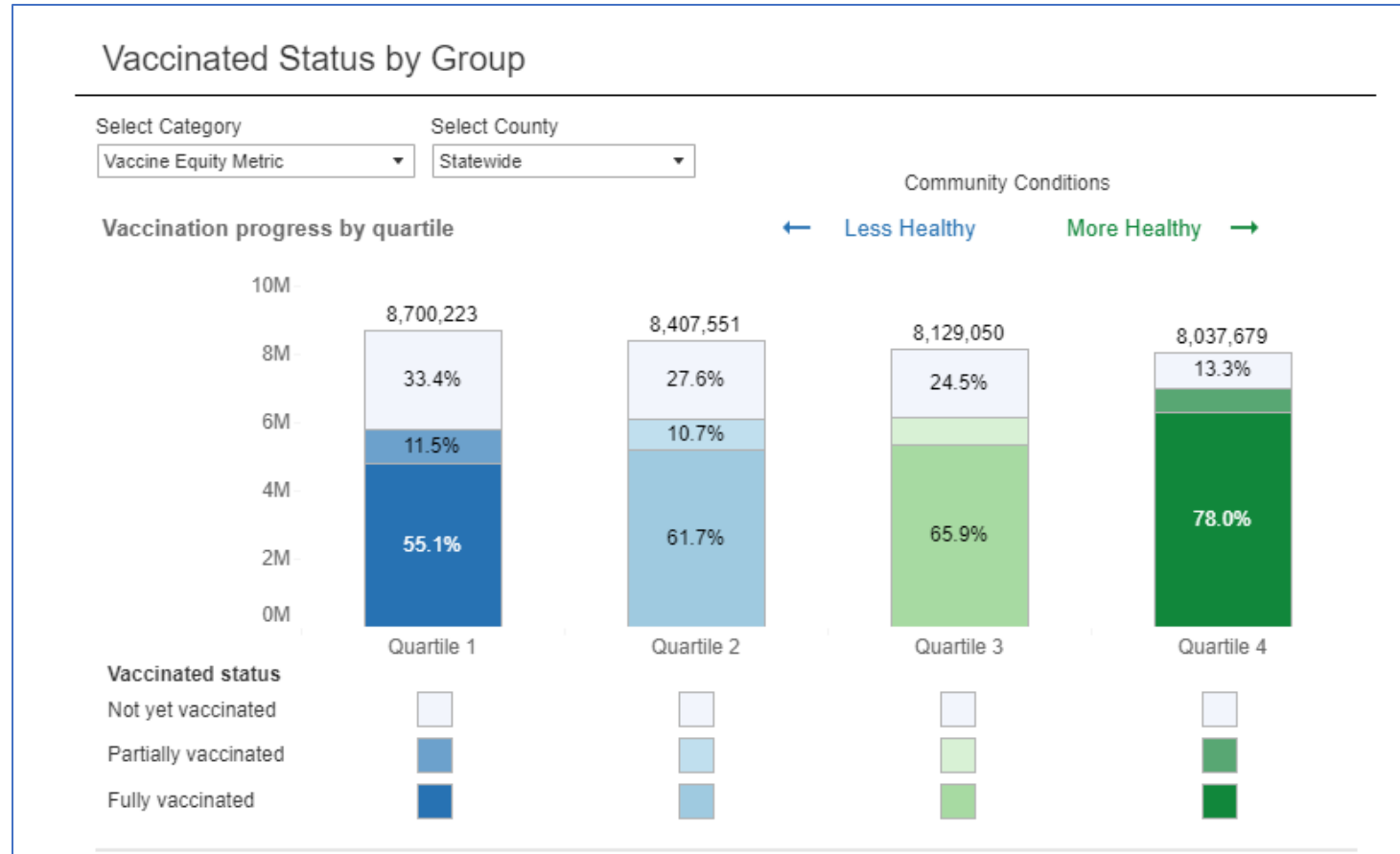
No loss of fertility was reported in the clinical trials or in the millions of women who have since received the vaccines.

Yes, the vaccine is safe for pregnant people. Pregnant people are at higher risk of getting very sick with COVID-19. Pregnant and lactating people may receive any of the authorized COVID-19 vaccines to protect themselves.

# Doses Administered to Date (8/25/21)

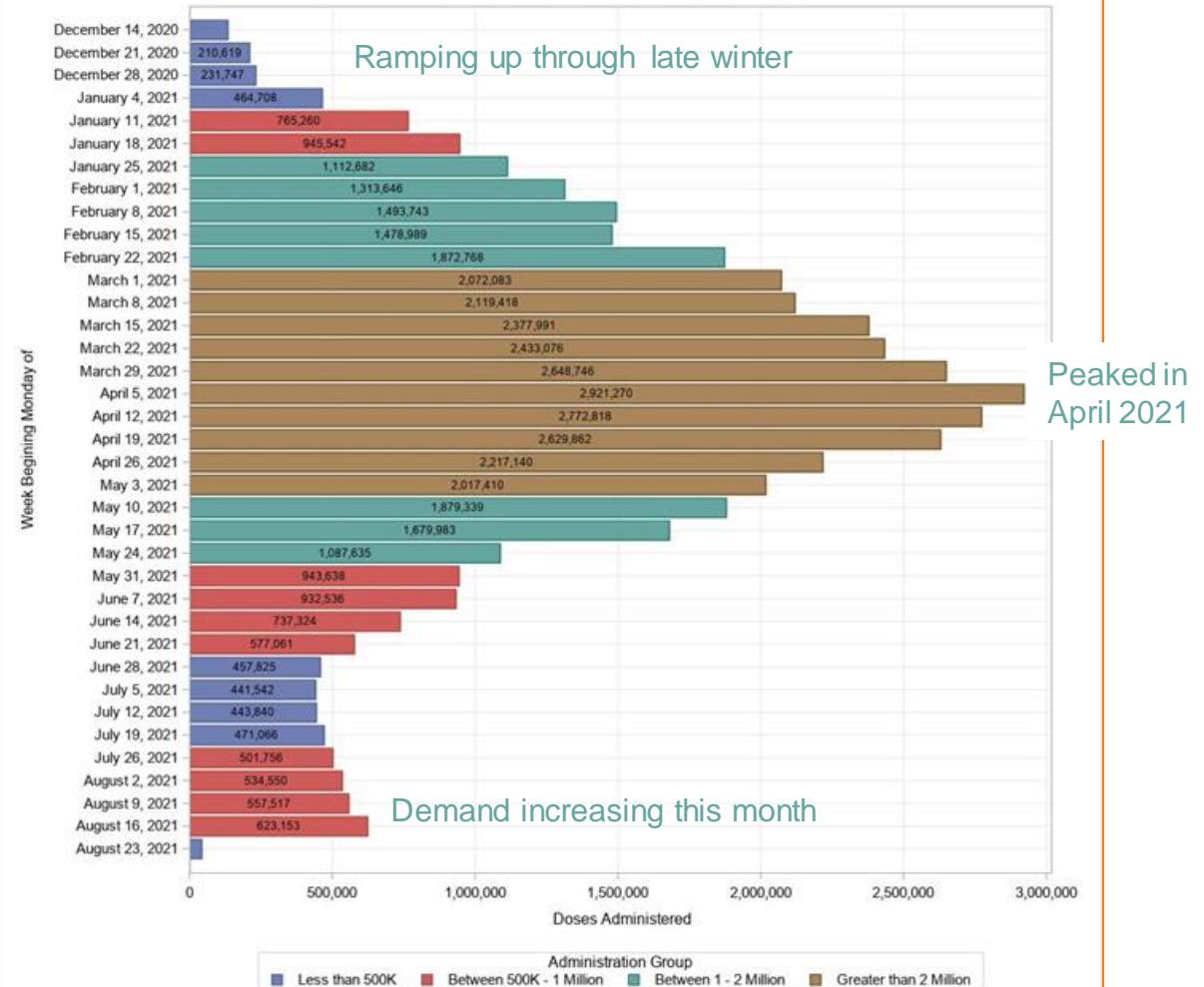
**46,390,955** doses administered!

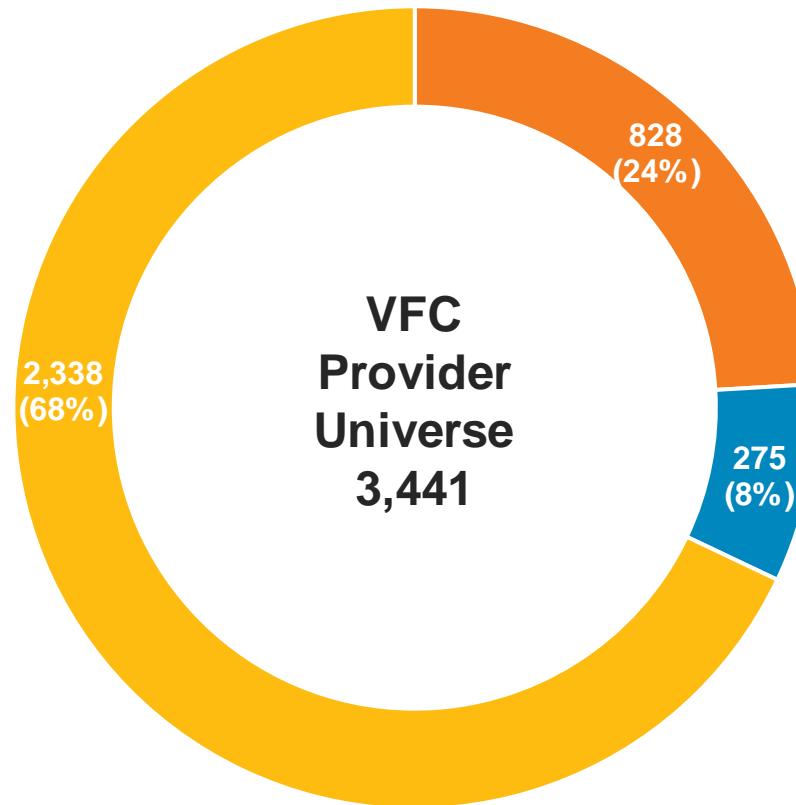

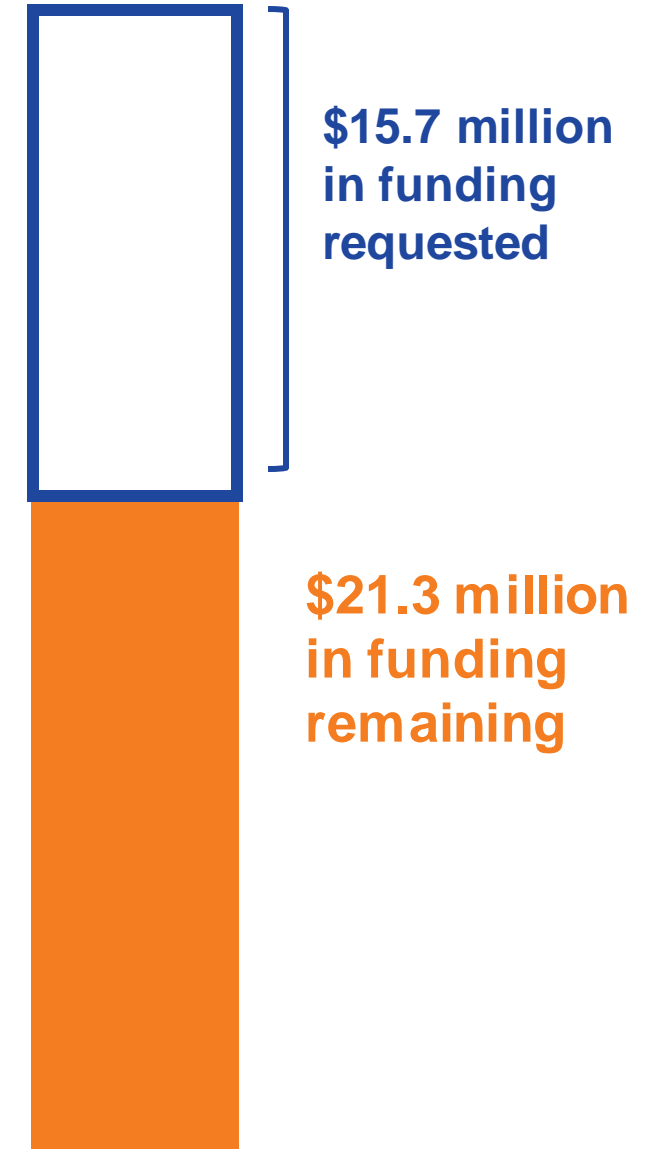

# FDA Approves First COVID-19 Vaccine | FDA

- FDA has approved Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine as Comirnaty (koe-mir'-na-tee) in ages 16 and older.
- Continue use in 12-15 years, and provide a third dose to immunocompromised individuals  $\geq 12$  under EUA
- FDA-approved Comirnaty and the FDA-authorized Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine have the same formulation and can be used interchangeably.

# COVID-19 Provider Use Agreement

- Vaccine providers are responsible for adhering to all requirements outlined in the provider agreement
  - Off-label may not be covered under the PREP Act → providers may not have immunity from claims.
  - Individuals who receive an off-label dose may not be eligible for compensation under the Countermeasures Injury Compensation Program after a possible adverse event.
  - Providers giving off-label doses would be in violation of the CDC Program provider agreement potentially impacting their ability to remain a provider in the CDC program.
  - Administration fees may not be reimbursable by payers.

# Additional Doses and Booster Doses

- August 12, 2021 – FDA authorized use of an *additional* dose of mRNA vaccine in immunocompromised patients
  - Increase immune response to vaccine in patients at risk of poor immune response due to immunocompromising condition/medications

# Pfizer Shelf-Life Extension

- FDA has approved an amendment to the EUA for Pfizer to extend the expiration date from 6 to 9 months.
- Cartons and vials of Pfizer vaccine with an expiry date of August 2021 through February 2022 printed on the label may remain in use for 3 months beyond the printed date as long as authorized storage conditions between  $-90^{\circ}\text{C}$  and  $-60^{\circ}\text{C}$  have been maintained
  - This extension does apply to vaccine that had been moved once into  $-25^{\circ}\text{C}$  to  $-15^{\circ}\text{C}$  and then back to ultracold storage
  - The extension does apply to vaccine that was recently moved into refrigeration (example: vaccine that originally expired 08/31 was moved into the refrigerator 08/25. You now have the entire 31-day shelf life to use the vaccine.)
- The extended expiration date is effective immediately for all currently available batches that have not yet expired



# Pfizer Shelf-life Extension – Cont.

- This change is based on stability data generated on batches manufactured over approximately the past nine months of COVID-19 vaccine development, from the batches that supplied early clinical trials through the commercial scale batches currently in production.

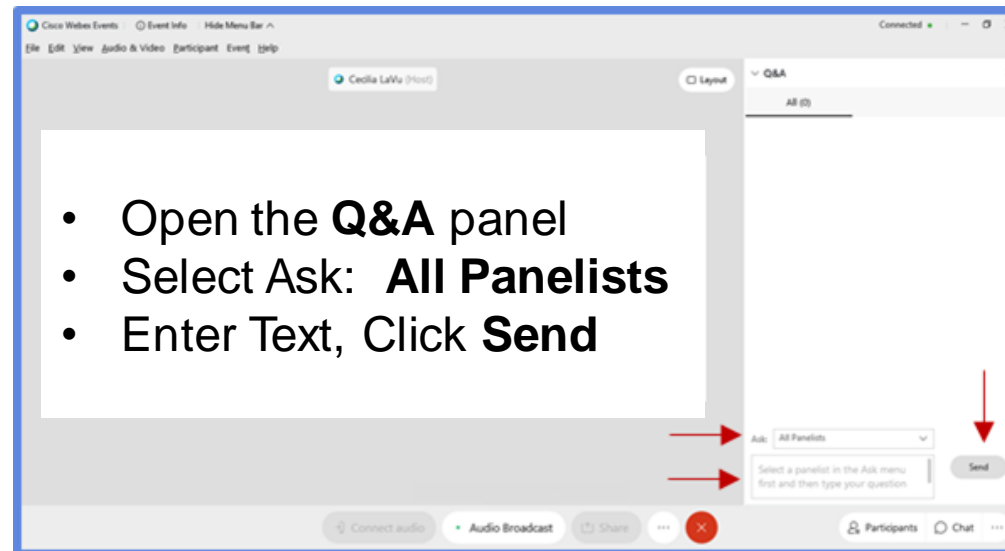
# Third Party Redistributor

- AmerisourceBergen will ship small quantities of Pfizer vaccine (30 doses minimum)
- Shipments will be packed with dry ice and shipped with a temperature range of -94°C to -15°C.
  - The vaccine and data logger will be packaged together in cushioned envelope.
  - Providers will need dry ice gloves to unpack the vaccine
- The shipments will include a data logger. The data logger can only be turned off by removing the logger from the envelope containing the vaccine.
- Providers will need to plug the data logger via USB into their computer to download the logger reading if an excursion showed on the screen. There is no special software required.
- Vials should be stored in the refrigerator (2°C to 8°C) upon receipt.

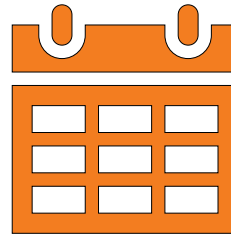
# Third Party Redistributor (TPR)\*

AmerisourceBergen will facilitate the distribution of **Small Order Pfizer vaccine** orders placed within the myCAvax system. The TPR will receive Pfizer vaccine at their facilities, repackage the vaccine and ancillary supplies, and distribute to Providers free of charge.



## Order Requirements

- 30 order **min**, 240 order **max**



## Order Timeframe

- Orders will **ship within 48 hours** of receiving the shipping file from CDPH (approval cadence TBD)
  - Delivery within 24 hours of shipment



## Order Tracking

- Providers will continue viewing *all* shipping records on myCAvax

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## Deliveries

- No orders will be delivered Labor Day MONDAY, September 6
  - **Pfizer:** No deliveries will occur on Monday, 9/6
