- **Mckesson shipments will not be delivered on Monday, May 30 and Tuesday, May 31.** Deliveries will resume Wednesday, June 1.
- **Pfizer shipments will not be delivered on Monday, May 30.** Deliveries will resume Tuesday, May 31.
- The COVID Call Center will be closed on Monday, May 30
