


Adding Bivalent Booster Walk-In Appointments Vaccine Administrators



Vaccine Administrators can now schedule walk-in appointments for Moderna and Pfizer Bivalent Booster doses.

- Under the Add Walk-in Appointment tab, select COVID-19 as the Vaccine Type and add the patient's details.
- 2. Click Next.
- 3. Enter the **Patient Background** details and **Contact Information**.






Adding Bivalent Booster Walk-In Appointments Vaccine Administrators

- 4. Under the Appointment Details section, you can now see the Bivalent Booster option added under the Which dose is this? dropdown field.
- Select Moderna or Pfizer from the Vaccine Brand dropdown options.
- 6. Click **Confirm Appointment.**



Updates to Friday Provider Office Hour Providers

Bivalent Booster Updates Providers





The **Third-Party Redistributor**, **AmerisourceBergen**, will redistribute small orders of Pfizer Bivalent Boosters, beginning this week. There's a 30 dose minimum and 294 dose maximum; order in multiples of 6 doses/vial.

CDPH anticipates that Providers can begin ordering the **Moderna Bivalent Booster** on **September 29**th, once CDPH receives our allocation from CDC. The CDC vaccine order system will be offline September 30th to October 1st, so orders placed on or after the 29th will be processed on **Monday, October 3rd**. LHD/MCE approval deadline for catch-up orders will still be 12 pm Friday, September 30th according to the regular order cadence.

What's New in myCAvax? - Release 30 **LHJs and Providers**



New updates for Providers, LHDs, and MCEs launched on September 16th.



- ✓ You will be able to track follow-up tasks on Site Visit objects including details like Follow-Up Name, Sub-question, Due Date, Comments, etc.
- √ You will see new fields "External Order Number" and "External Status" on vaccine orders that contain information on the MPX integration from MuleSoft / NextGen.
- ✓ You will be able to create and edit Storage Units for locations.
- ✓ You will be able to create waste events on the internal Salesforce Admin side for all vaccine types, including MPX.

✓ Account status changes will no longer be tracked in the Chatter feed history for Providers.




Creating Storage Capacities LHJs



LHDs/MCEs may create and edit storage capacities for Provider locations from the Sys Admin portal.

- Navigate to the Storage and Handling tab on the desired Provider location account.
- 2. Click the **Caret** to edit an existing storage unit.
- 3. Click **New** to create a new storage unit.






Recording Waste Events LHJs



LHJs can record waste events from the Salesforce System Admin Portal for both COVID-19 and MPX vaccines.






MPX Ordering: New Fields and Shipment Records



There are two new fields visible for MPX vaccine orders 1) the **External Order Number** and 2) **External Status**. These fields are visible from the **Details** tab of an individual vaccine order. Note that MPX vaccine should be requested in **vials**, not **doses**!





LHJs

MPX Ordering Overview LHJs



Current State:

Currently, Monkeypox (MPX) vaccine distribution is ordered through SNS and is limited to 5 sites per state. The MPX vaccine is distributed to the CDPH warehouse and the L.A. warehouse. LHJs can now place orders for MPX vaccine from the myCAvax Vaccine Order Review page and these orders will be transmitted to the CDPH warehouse for fulfillment. L.A. County LHD will continue to manage their jurisdiction's MPX ordering.

LHJs can now record their MPX transfers to Provider locations. COVID-19 vaccine enrolled Providers receiving MPX vaccines can record their waste events in myCAvax.

Future State:

- CDC has announced that a new contractor, AmerisourceBergen, will be coming on board to expand the number of sites that can be shipped to.
- CDC will be shifting to a new vaccine ordering system, Health Partner Order Portal (HPoP), for direct Provider orders. HPoP does not support LHJ allocations.



Ordering & Approving MPX Orders for LHJ Locations LHJs




Create and approve MPX vaccine orders from the **Vaccine Order Review** tab for your LHJ location that will be receiving MPX vaccines (e.g., a warehouse, distribution center, etc.).

1. Create a MPX order using the Create New Order(s) button and select your LHJ Location account as the recipient.

Note: Input the number of vials requested under Requested Quantity, not doses.

- 2. Approve the order.
- 3. The order status will automatically update as the warehouse processes the MPX order. Orders will be processed and shipped within 24 48 hours.

Known Issues

Accounts Incorrectly Put On Hold?

- Accounts who have had order/transfer activity in the past 180 days may have been incorrectly placed on hold
- We will correct our logic to prevent this from occurring in the future
