Outbreak Response Teams <i>urgent deployment</i>	A 24–48-hour urgent response team for an acute, localized outbreak. Services can include a combination of testing and vaccination, contact investigation and tracing, monoclonal antibody therapy, infection prevention, and/or as needed state epidemiologist engagement. State funds cover these services.	Follow your MHOAC process to submit a request. Turnkey Mobile Vaccination and Pop-Up Clinics (for non-school locations) <i>non-urgent requests</i>	Turnkey mobile and pop-up clinic solutions (van, PPE, staff) are available to vaccinate in community settings. LHJs need to identify sites and provide vaccine. 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Turnkey Mobile Vaccination/Pop-Up Clinics or Vaccination Related Staffing (for school located clinics) <i>non-urgent requests</i>	CDPH can fund on-site vaccination resources (staff or turnkey services) for school-located COVID-19 or Flu vaccine events if they take place at schools to vaccinate students. Fulfillment of turnkey or staff support from the state for-coadministration will be based on state capacity.
