Outbreak Response Teams urgent deployment	A 24–48-hour urgent response team for an acute, localized outbreak. Services can include a combination of testing and vaccination, contact investigation and tracing, monoclonal antibody therapy, infection prevention, and/or as needed state epidemiologist engagement.
