The following information is required by your vaccine clinic/provider.

Minor Consent

I declare that I am (must check one):

- The parent of the minor patient.
- The legal guardian of the minor patient.
- An emancipated minor at least 16 years of age.
- A person with authority to make healthcare decisions on behalf of the minor patient.

I attest to the following (all boxes must be checked in order for the minor to be vaccinated):

- I have read and understood the Vaccine Information Statement below for the seasonal influenza vaccine and understand the risks and benefits.

Vaccine Information Statement ([flu shot](#) / [nasal spray](#))

- I GIVE CONSENT for the minor patient to receive the influenza vaccine. [If you do NOT give consent, do not complete this form.]
- I understand that by providing my voluntary consent, the minor patient can receive the influenza vaccine with or without a parent or guardian being physically present at the vaccination appointment.
- I consent to and authorize all medically necessary treatment in the rare event that the minor patient has a reaction to the vaccine, including but not limited to itching, swelling, fainting, anaphylaxis, and other reactions.

By typing my name and today's date in the boxes below, I am providing consent for the minor patient to receive the influenza vaccine and certify that (1): I am authorized to provide this consent and (2) all of the information I have provided on this form is true and correct to the best of my knowledge:





Nasal Spray Available Tag:

To add a Nasal Spray Available Tag, Clinic Managers must:

1. Create a separate clinic for the flu Nasal Spray
2. **Set up a clinic flow (step 1):** Indicate they offer Nasal Spray in the Clinic Settings Section
3. Select the **Nasal Spray Available** checkbox on the Clinic Details page

Add Walk-In Appointment Tab

functionality

Vaccine Type (flu or COVID-19):

Vaccine Type question and validation added to ensure clinic staff select clinics for the correct vaccine type in the Appointment Details section (Clinic Name Field)*

functionality

View Clinic Hours button:

View Clinic Hours button added to bottom of first page in "Add Walk-In Appointment" tab to ensure appointments are created within clinic hours*

Patient Date-of-Birth validation:

Validation added to Add Walk-In Appointment flow to ensure vaccine eligibility by age*

Managing Appointments

functionality

Home page:

- Vaccine Type and Vaccine Brand filters added to Appointment Search section*
- Vaccine Administrators can sort by Type (COVID-19 or flu) in the Appointment Tab*

Bulk Update:

Validation added to prevent clinic staff from bulk updating COVID-19 and flu appointments at the same time*

Patient Date-of-Birth validation

Validation added to ensure different Funding Sources are reflected based on patient's age

Patient Information

functionality

Minor Consent:

Validation added to ensure different Funding Sources are reflected based on patient's age

functionality

Screening Questions:

Additional screening questions added for patients interested in receiving the flu nasal spray*

interface

Vaccination Details page:

If the patient indicates they have an allergy to a component of the vaccine, a notice is displayed at the bottom of the Vaccination Details page, reminding the Vaccine Administrator and/or Assistant to monitor the patient for adverse reactions
