## Booster Eligibility and Screening Questions

### Let's Get Started page:

Screening Questions updated on the Let's Get Started page to ensure patients scheduling Booster appointments meet one of the following eligibility criteria:

- 65+
- 18-64 and in any of these groups
  - Resident of a long-term care facility (for example nursing home or assisted living for seniors)
  - At high risk for COVID-19 complications
  - At high risk for COVID-19 exposure due to occupation or institutional setting
- 50-64 and at increased risk of social inequities

#### Which appointment would you like to schedule?

The Pfizer vaccine is available as an Additional dose or a Booster dose. Additional doses are for immunocompromised patients who received their second dose at least 28 days ago. Booster doses are for eligible people who received their second dose at least 6 months ago.



### Recommended Workflow

- (1) Create a **new clinic** for Additional Dose / Booster vaccine supply only
- (2) Add "Booster Only", "Additional Dose Only", or "Additional Dose/ Booster Only" to the **Clinic Name**
- (3) Check the "**Additional Dose/Booster**" checkbox in the "What types of appointments will your clinic host? Please select all that apply." field
- (4) Utilize the following fields to control clinic's visibility on My Turn Public:
  - a) Exclude from Public Site checkbox
  - b) Availability Date
  - c) Clinic Start Date
