Dreams don't have [expiration dates](#), but vaccines do!

Your practice is responsible for every dose of VFC-supplied vaccine you receive. Store and manage vaccines properly.

Your patients are counting on you.

- ***Never use expired vaccines.***
- Check expiration dates and rotate stock regularly.
- Place vaccines that will expire soonest in front of those with later expiration dates.
- Transfer vaccines that will expire within six months to other VFC providers. Always notify the VFC Call Center prior to transferring vaccines.
- Report expired vaccines on MyVFCVaccines.org prior to submitting a new order.
