- The lot number to be recorded should be taken from the label on the package/box.

- Infants with severe latex allergies should not receive RotaTeq.
- Do not begin series in infants older than 14 weeks, 6 days of age. Infants with severe latex allergies should not receive RotaTeq.
- Infants diagnosed with severe combined immunodeficiency disease (SCFD) or a history of intussusception should not receive RotaTeq.
