Protects Against	Measles, Mumps, Rubella & Varicella
Approved Ages	12 months–12 years

Routine Schedule	2-dose series: 1 st dose at 12–15 months & 2 nd dose at 4–6 years
Minimum Intervals	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> At least 3 months should elapse between doses 1 & 2 of ProQuad® or a varicella-containing vaccine At least 1 month between a dose of a measles-containing vaccine (e.g., MMR) and a dose of ProQuad®
Administration	Subcutaneous (SC) or Intramuscular (IM) injection
Packaging	Vaccine packaged as 10 single-dose vials of lyophilized vaccine (Package A) and a separate package of 10 vials of sterile water diluent (Package B)
Storage	Store frozen between -58°F and 5°F (-50°C and -15°C) Store in freezer. Protect vaccine from light.
