Let's kick off January right and prepare to stay safe during this winter season and throughout the new year.

In California and throughout the country, we are experiencing heavy wind and rain, causing flooding, mudslides, and power outages. Always prioritize patient and staff safety during emergencies. Follow this safety checklist to help your clinic prepare for and stay safe during vaccine-related emergencies.

- ✓ **Know how to respond in case of an emergency** – review the [Provider Operations Manual](#) (POM) and keep it easily accessible in case there is a power outage or system malfunction.
- ✓ **Review and update your clinic's [Vaccine Management Plan](#)** – keep this updated and near storage units to prevent vaccine loss.
- ✓ **Replace or Recalibrate your Digital Data Logger (DDL) if needed** – make sure batteries are replaced and you have a backup DDL during an emergency. Know when recalibration is due. Follow these [DDL guidelines](#).
