Nirsevimab (BeyfortusTM) – Temporary Pause in Ordering

Dear VFC Provider,

CDC recently notified states that in light of high demand and limited supply of nirsevimab (BeyfortusTM), they are temporarily pausing public health ordering of this immunization. Starting the week of 10/16/23, CDC will be implementing allocations for nirsevimab (BeyfortusTM) to each state to ensure equitable supply availability. As a result, nirsevimab (BeyfortusTM) is temporarily unavailable for ordering.

The California VFC Program expects to open up Nirsevimab (Beyfortus[™]) ordering again later this week. To allow for smaller but more frequent orders, the VFC Program is allowing all providers to order Nirsevimab (Beyfortus[™]) monthly, regardless of your routine order frequency. Order enough vaccine for your VFC-eligible infants that can be used within the monthly order timeframe. Vaccine requests will be reviewed and approved based on a providers' reported VFC patient population and orders may be reduced based on available allocated supply. Given that VFC vaccine supply will

be allocated, doses of Nirsevimab (Beyfortus[™]) must be administered to VFC eligible patients only. Borrowing is not allowed.

Nirsevimab (Beyfortus[™]) orders that have already been approved will be processed and shipped as soon as more supply is received at our national vaccine distributor, McKesson.
