


Vaccine Tips

'Tis the season for vaccinating! The holidays are upon us, so protect patients before traveling and gathering.



- Take every opportunity to protect patients against respiratory diseases, especially <u>flu, COVID, and RSV as</u> <u>activity is increasing</u>.
- Check out <u>CDC's National Influenza</u> <u>Vaccination Week toolkit</u> for fun promotional materials for families.
- Administer <u>RSV immunization</u> to all infants <8 months or 8-19 months (if high risk).
- Another option to protect babies is to administer VFC <u>maternal RSV</u>

vaccination (Abrysvo) to all eligible VFC pregnant patients.

- Enter all VFC RSV doses given to birth parents and babies in CAIR!
- Promote the <u>digital vaccine record</u> (DVR) to verify prenatal RSV vaccine status.
