Get patients [caught up on vaccines](#) this summer!



- It's important to get patients caught up on vaccines before [traveling](#) to prevent outbreaks like [measles](#).
- Babies 6-11 months of age traveling internationally should get a measles vaccine before departure.
- Remind parents and guardians to make sure their children are up to date on [required school vaccines](#) before the back-to-school rush!

- Log in to your myCAvax account and navigate to 'Provider Locator' in the 'More' tab to opt in and display your practice on the map today!
- Update your vaccines offered and clinic hours as often as needed to help new patients find your practice and set up vaccine appointments.
