**Summer is here and travel is increasing.
Vaccinate patients to keep everyone safe!**



Measles is still increasing in California, especially due to travel. Follow these tips to keep patients protected this summer:

- Always check patient vaccine records and recommend any overdue vaccines. If no record of measles vaccine exists in a patient's record or their [CA Digital Vaccine Record \(DVR\)](#) make sure to strongly recommend measles vaccination before travel.
- Ask parents about travel plans with their family when patients come in for visits.
- Share travel immunization resources with families:
 - 11 California counties have confirmed cases. See the [CDPH Measles Disease Page](#) for more information on measles activity in the state.
 - Use tools from the [Measles Toolkit](#) to promote measles vaccination to patients.
