





#### **Participation details**


Collectively, sites have ordered a total of 8,167 doses of VFC vaccines in an 18-month period (September 2023 - February 2025)

- 28% (2,250 doses) COVID-19
- 64% (5,187 doses) Routine
- 9% (730 doses) Flu





### Requirements for VFC Pharmacy Pilot Participation

- Meet VFC Program requirements
- Administer flu vaccine to all VFC-eligible children ages 3 18 years
- Must have vaccine storage equipment that meets VFC Program requirements
- Report doses to CAIR or RIDE
  - Electronic data submission
  - Manual data submission
- Vaccine ordering
- Participate in required surveys, webinars, and/or other VFC-related activities





# Medi-Cal Reimbursement of Pharmacies as Vaccines for Children (VFC)-Enrolled Providers



### **Effective Date and Requirements**

Effective August 2024, DHCS will reimburse pharmacy providers as Vaccines for Children (VFC) Providers.

- Pharmacy must be enrolled under Medi-Cal.
- Pharmacy must enroll as a VFC provider.
- Pharmacist must enroll as ORP under Medi-Cal.
- Reimbursement is in accordance with the statutory authority of <u>Welfare</u> and <u>Institution Code Section 14132.968 (3)</u>, under Pharmacist Services.

# **Pharmacy Reimbursement Details**

Three different services can be billed for administering a VFC vaccine to a Medi-Cal member:

- 1. Vaccine Administration
- 2. Professional Dispensing Fee
- 3. Pharmacist Services (Evaluation and assessment for vaccination)

Reimbursement rates for Pharmacies are 85% of that of Medical Providers pursuant to Welfare and Institutions Code, section 14132.968.

Cost of the vaccine will not be reimbursed since supplied free under the VFC program.

Billing is under the pharmacy, not individual pharmacists.



### 2024 VFC Vaccines




Over 1150 VFC vaccines administered in 2024

### Key Points – VFC Program



- •Partners should encourage parents to provide all vaccine records CAIR often not updated and very helpful when families bring vaccine records to planned events
- •Become familiar with reading vaccination records from other countries vaccine names and combinations can differ from U.S.
- Screening process training
- •Can take awhile between ordering and receiving VFC vaccines plan ahead
- •Balance between having enough vaccines and too many providers are responsible for expired / wasted vaccines
- •Always reach out to your VFC assigned representatives with any issues amazingly helpful group

## Successes and Challenges

# elements PHARMACY

#### Successes ©

- •Lot's of VFC vaccines administered in various settings
- VFC vaccines are a super helpful additional service available for the community
- Great support from the VFC program

### Challenges 😊

- •Billing Medi-Cal vs. MCP for initiation fee
- •Failed cooler as a new provider resulting in spoiled varicella vaccine
- Balancing vaccine inventory and provider responsibility for spoiled/wasted vaccines risk of expired vaccines
- Maintaining separate stock when providing mobile clinics As a new provider, mobile clinic vaccinator has administered commercial vaccines instead of VFC.
   Be sure to have a solid process for storing vaccines.

### Vaccines for Children – Medi-Cal Billing – What is Covered?



- Professional Services Vaccine Administration
  - •FFS and Managed Care Plan (MCP) members (pharmacy claim or medical claim) OR as a medical claim using CPT coding \$7.65
- Vaccine Initiation Fee (Consultation and Assessment)
  - •Must be submitted as a medical claim (FFS to DHCS, MCP members to the MCP)
    - ■FFS: 99202 = \$29.16, 99212 = \$15.39
    - MCP: Refer to MCP rates
- Professional Dispensing Fee \$13.20 or \$10.05 (Remember to submit your survey in March 2025)
  - •FFS and Managed Care Plan (MCP) members (pharmacy claim or medical claim) OR as a medical claim using CPT coding

### Vaccines for Children – Medi-Cal Billing – What is Covered?



 Vaccine cost is not reimbursed because VFC vaccines are free to pharmacies

Commercial COVID-19 vaccines are payable by Medi-Cal for >3yo Administration fee after 10/1/2024 is \$34.00

Billing is retroactive to January 1, 2023

### Ordering and Rendering Provider (ORP)



- The ordering pharmacist must be enrolled in Medi-Cal as an Ordering, Referring and Prescribing (ORP) provider
- Pharmacists must obtain an individual (Type 1) NPI number. An Organizational (Type 2) NPI number is not acceptable
- Enrollment via PAVE


