Increase immunizations this season!



As case rates for <u>flu</u>, <u>COVID-19</u>, and <u>RSV</u> start to increase during these fall and winter months, it's important to keep immunizing patients. Schedule immunization appointments and consider holding special vaccination events for flu, COVID-19, and RSV for both your patients and your community!

Continue following these tips to increase IZ rates:

- **Promote getting both flu and updated COVID-19 vaccines:** It is safe and convenient to get both in one visit. Download this flu and COVID-19 flyer for kids!
